Soapstone Heater Workshops (Heater Drawings Attached)

Rod Zander will design and instruct the fabrication and building of a soapstone heater which will be based on the Kachelofen interior design and calculations.

Fabrication Workshop at New England Hearth & Soapstone in Goshen, CT

Date: July 9th – 13th.

Lodging: Tenting and bunking available – motels close by.

Soapstone Heater Workshop - MHA Headquarters in Randolph, VT

Date: August 13 – 17th

Lodging: Tenting and bunking available at Fox Brush Farm – motels close by.

A **third** workshop will be held to build a **le Panyol** outdoor cooking oven at MHA Headquarters also. The **le Panyol** is a baking/cooking oven core kit system of all natural, semi insulative refractory block elements from France. Jean Pivard, our MHA member from France presented the le Panyol at our Wildacres Annual Meeting in May and we enjoyed 40+ pizzas in a very short time.
