## MHA Educational Class Schedule for 2014

Courses below are introductory and titled "Basics and Theory of Masonry Heaters". The educational classes presented by MHA are part of the HMED (Heater Masons Education & Development) Program.

A minimum number of students need to enroll in a class for that class to take place. In order to obtain supplies, print text books, and other preparations, the following dates have been set as deadlines for registrations. The sooner registrations are made the sooner the class becomes viable.

June 19-22	at Everett, Washington	Registration Deadline: May 19th
Aug. 07-10	at Cummingham, MA.	Registration Deadline: July 07th
Aug. 14-17	at Duluth, MN.	Registration Deadline: July 14th
Sep. 11-14	at Perth, Ontario	Registration Deadline: Aug. 11th

The Cost of attending: \$800

This cost is for the course only and you will have to supply your own lodging. Lunch and refreshments are provided.

The course is approximately 32 hours long. About 12 hours are classroom and 20 hours building the core for a masonry heater. During the build you will have the opportunity to help construct a core.

It is important that the student realize that this is an excellent first step in learning to build masonry heaters. The course is not intended to or should imply that the student will be able to construct masonry heaters for customers.

Class sizes are limited and registration is on a first come first serve basis. Registration deadline is 30 days prior to the class. MHA may cancel a class if needed and all registration funds will be refunded.

If the student wants to become a professional heater builder, the HMED class can be used as one of the requirements needed for certification.
